Congregational Prayer

We pray that many who are unchurched will hear Your Word and receive Your salvation. Send Your Holy Spirit to help us in that dream for the Kingdom of God.

Thank You that even when we are faithless, You remain faithful and wait patiently for us to return. Thank you for the problems, conflicts, and tests that make us return to You when we stray. Make us ready to hear and obey Your call for our lives, no matter how difficult or unusual it may be. Use us, we pray, to share the Good News of salvation to those who are dead in their sin and do not know they need You.

Give us ears to hear You and mouths to speak Your Good News to others.

These and all our unspoken petitions we pray today, knowing that You have sought us, found us, and claimed us as Your children. We pray in the way our Savior taught us:
